Online Tenders are invited on behalf of the Director Inter-University Accelerator Centre (IUAC), Aruna Asaf Ali Marg, New Delhi-110067 through e-Procurement Portal under two bid system, viz., Technical and Financial bids, from eligible and experienced parties for the “**Annual maintenance and operation of Audio & Video Systems within IUAC Campus, New Delhi**”.

Incomplete/Bids not covering full scope of work included in the bid document, will be rejected and only complete bids will be considered. Tenderers / Contractors / Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the e-procurement portal. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. The Director, IUAC reserves the right to accept / reject any / all tenders in part / full without assigning any reasons whatsoever, and decision of IUAC in this regard will be binding on all bidders.

Bidder has to select the payment option as “online” to pay the tender fee/EMD as applicable by going to link: <https://services.sabpaisa.in/pages/iuac.html>. The earnest money deposit shall be in the form of online payment and it should be deposited before the bid opening. Bidders registered with MSME/NSIC are exempted from payment of EMD & tender fee. Copy of valid registration certificate should be uploaded in the website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled and submit it online without modifying the format. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

Any Corrigendum / Amendments in respect of above tender shall be issued on IUAC website www.iuac.res.in and website <https://eprocure.gov.in> only. Bidders should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document and in case of any correspondence for clarifications needed, they may contact Administrative Officer (S&P) before submitting their bids.

Part-I: GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. **Submission of Tender:** Tenders should be uploaded on CPP portal in two Parts i.e. “Technical Bid” (Part-A) and “Price Bid/BOQ” (Part-B).

2. **Technical Bid (Part-A):** In this bid, the bidder shall upload the following relevant documents which are essential for technical qualification:

- a. Earnest money deposit proof
- b. Copies of PAN Number, GST Registration Number certificates of bidding agency
- c. PF Registration number
- d. ESI Registration number
- e. The bidder should have office in Delhi /NCR so as to ensure timely resolution of issues pertaining to concerned work. Company profile with annual Financial turnover of Rs 10 Lakh and above for the last three financial years should be submitted.
- f. Copies of work orders of similar type of works executed successfully during the last 3 years as on 31st March 2020 in Govt., Public sector, Autonomous body or reputed Public Ltd. Company, with at least one work of value not less than Rs.8.0 lakhs or two similar works, each of value not less than Rs. 5.0 lakhs or three similar works, each of value not less than Rs. 4.0 lakhs.
- g. Satisfactory work completion certificate with contract details. The work order and completion certificates with contract details. The work order and completion certificates should be for the same work. These details must include particulars of contract awarded by the concerned organisation indicating the period / scope of contract, number and type of personnel engaged.
- h. Tender Acceptance Letter shall be duly signed & stamped by the bidder.
- i. Certificate/Undertaking of site visit.
(**Note:** All documents uploaded by the bidder should be self-attested along with stamp).
- j. The bidder shall not be black listed by any government or government department in centre/state/district levels across India. An undertaking in this regard as per Annexure-V be enclosed with the technical bid.

3. **Price Bid (Part-B):** In this bid, the bidder is required to quote his item rates in the Schedule of Rates in accordance with the scope of work, terms & conditions. The rates/price quoted by contractor should be all inclusive (except CGST, SGST, IGST which are payable separately as quoted in price bid). Nothing over and above these rates shall be payable to contractor. Further nothing extra in rates will be considered for any variations in tender quantities or due to any site difficulties. The bidders should quote unconditional rates, neatly written without any overwriting and all pages should be duly signed & stamped.

Earnest Money: Bidder has to select the payment option as “online” to pay the tender fee and EMD as applicable by going to link: <https://services.sabpaisa.in/pages/iuac.html>. The earnest money deposit shall be in the form of online payment and it should be deposited before the bid

opening. Bidders registered with MSME/NSIC are exempted from payment of EMD & tender fee. Copy of valid registration certificate should be uploaded in the website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

EMD of technically disqualified bidders & lowest 4th bidder onwards will be returned within 15 days from the date of evaluation of the technical bids. The refund of EMD to the unsuccessful bidders shall be made after awards of work and site mobilisation by the successful bidder. EMD of successful bidder shall be adjusted against the security deposit, if any and it will be refunded only on completion of contract period.

4. Exemption from EMD: Units registered with National Small Scale Industries Corporation (NSIC) as MSME are exempted from payment of EMD, subjected to:

- The unit being registered with MSME/NSIC for the items tendered.
- Self attested copy of valid MSME/NSIC registration Certificate is enclosed.
- Photocopy of application for registration at NSIC or for renewal of MSME/NSIC will not be acceptable. Such offers will be treated as offers received without EMD.

5. Validity of contract: The initial contract will be for a period of one year and can be extended based on same terms and conditions on mutual consent for further period of two year. However, the IUAC shall have full power to terminate the contract if the quality of service is not functioning to the satisfaction.

6. Validity of Tender: Tender shall be valid for our acceptance without any change in rates and NIT conditions for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of price bid. The validity of rates is extendable for a period of 180 days from the date of issue of award letter with mutual consent of both the parties. No tenderer can withdraw/or modify his tender or revoke the same within the said period of 90 days. If a tenderer on his own withdraws or revokes the tender or revises or alters or modifies the tender for any item or condition within a period of aforesaid 90 days, his earnest money deposit shall stand forfeited.

7. Escalation: No escalation over and above rates quoted by the bidder shall be paid during the execution of contract.

8. Scope of Work: Detailed scope of work, terms and conditions, technical specifications, list of approved makes etc. are enclosed with this NIT as **Part-II**: “Scope of Work with Special Terms & Conditions “.

9. Deviations: No deviation from the stipulated commercial terms and conditions will be allowed. Tender should be unconditional.

10. Site Conditions: Bidder shall acquaint himself fully with the site conditions by visiting various audio & video equipment installations (refer Annexure:VI) covered under this tender, understanding the requirement and the working environment of the IUAC before quoting his rates by visiting the site on any working day during normal office hours. The bidder shall also submit a

Certificate/Undertaking as per attached format regarding the site visit (Annexure-I). No compensation on account of any site difficulties will be entertained at a later date after award of works. Arrangement for site visit can be made by contacting Engineer-in-charge / A.O (S & P), Telephone No. 011-24126018 & 24126022 or through email: venkat@iuac.res.in through email well in advance before the due date of submission of tender. No claim for extension of time shall be entertained in this regard.

11. Performance Security: Successful bidders awarded the work order for carrying out the jobs on the basis of this Tender enquiry shall be required to furnish a Performance Security of the amount equivalent to 10% of the total contract value in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) or Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled Commercial Indian Bank to be submitted within 10 days on the receipt of the award letter/Letter of Intent(LoI) by them. The Performance Bank Guarantee should remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of maintenance contract. It would be refundable only after successful completion of maintenance contract. In case, the contract is further extended beyond one year, the Performance Bank Guarantee will have to be accordingly renewed by the successful bidder.

In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder awarded the Contract to furnish Performance Security, within the stipulated time, the contract awarded shall be cancelled.

12. The time allowed for the maintenance work is One Year to be reckoned from the 10th day after the date of written purchase/work order to commence the maintenance work.

13. If a tenderer whose tender is accepted fails to undertake the maintenance work as per terms of the contract within 10 days to be reckoned from the date of issue of award letter/LoI, the earnest money deposited will be forfeited.

14. IUAC does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.

15. This notice inviting tender will form part of the contract agreement to be executed by the successful tender with the IUAC.

16. In case the Tenderer desires to close the contract before the scheduled period, a notice of three months to the Institute is mandatory, failing which notice period shall be completed at the risk and cost of the contractor, besides damages as deemed suitable to the Institute shall be levied on the contractor. Notwithstanding contained anything above, Institute reserves the right to take any other action, including termination of contract at any time by giving one month's notice.

17. The necessary details of the staff members shall be given in advance so as to know and allow the individual to attend complaint.

18. No worker below the age of 18 years shall be employed on work.

19. The Contractor shall deploy his personnel only after obtaining the Institute approval duly submitting curriculum vitae (CV)/ Bio-Data of the personnel, the Institute shall be informed at least one week in advance and contractor shall be required to obtain the Institute's approval for all such changes along with their CV's.

20. The list of workers to be deployed shall be made available to the Institute and if any change is required on part of the Contractor or Institute, fresh list of staff along with relevant documents shall be made available by the contractor for each and every change, after seeking prior approval of the competent Authority of the Institute.

21. All the personnel and their bag and baggage connected with the contract shall be liable to physical check both at the time of entry in to the campus and during the exit at the Security Gate. The Contractor's personnel shall not stay beyond the specified working hours unless they are required to do so. They shall strictly comply with all security regulations of the Institute.

22. The employees of the contractor deployed on the above job shall have no right to claim for absorption in the services of IUAC and/or no claim for continuation/completion of the above contract tenure.

23. The contractor will have to deposit the proof of depositing employer's/employee's contribution towards PF/ESI etc., of each employee deployed in the Institute, on monthly basis. On deployment of worker(s), within two months, the contractor will provide Universal account number (UAN) for Provident Fund remittances along with other relevant details to the workers concerned and to the Institute for verification. Non-compliance of the foregoing requirements may lead to withholding of payment of contractor besides other punitive measures as deemed fit to the Institute.

24. Any damage caused to any equipment/or items available in the office premises due to negligence of the contractor's work force shall be entirely on contractor account. The amount so involved on this account shall be deducted from the payment due to contractor.

25. If the performance of the contractor is not up to the mark then IUAC may take the following actions. A) To engage another contractor, B) To terminate his contract.

26. As per law of land, statutory deductions like Income Tax / GSTDS and other mandatory /statutory deductions etc. shall be made from the contractor's bill as applicable.

27. If any worker is found to be not suitable for the position, the contractor has to remove the person from the site immediately and substitute posted. The decision of Institute in this regard shall be final and binding on the contractor.

28. In case of leave of any staff, a substitute has to be arranged by the contractor who has got the required qualification and adequate experience.

29. The agency shall provide police verification document and character certificate of the employee along with other documents of qualification, experience etc.

30. All the pages of the tender should be signed by the owner of the firm or his authorized signatory. In case the tenders are signed by the authorized signatory, a copy of the power of attorney / authorization may be enclosed along with tender.

31. There should be no case pending with the police against the Proprietor / Firm/Partner or the Company (Agency).

32. Attendance register of the staff shall be maintained by the agency and the same shall be submitted on daily basis or as desired by the Institute. The manpower deployed by agency should invariably mark their attendance in the attendance system provided by the institute. The institute reserves the right of surprise verification of attendance of manpower deployed, by the committee authorized to do so on any day. The payment will be released on the basis of attendance marked in attendance system of the institute.

33. Any accident / electrocution caused due to negligence or during the course of normal work etc., shall be responsibility of the Contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for all compensation to the staff engaged by him.

34. The Institute will not be responsible, if any accident/casualty occurs or whatsoever due to negligence of worker employed & no compensation shall be paid by the Institute.

35. The contractor shall provide sufficient safeguard to avoid any accident.

36. The contractor shall not sublet or transfer any part of the contract thereof without the written permission of the Director, IUAC, New Delhi.

37. If any agency quotes rates below minimum wages, his tender shall be rejected.

38. The wages of deployed staff shall be payable as per minimum wages fixed by Govt. Of National Territory Delhi. The statutory increase or decrease in wages from time to time by Govt. Of NCT shall be reimbursed on production of having paid the said increase.

39. The agency shall submit the analysis for the rates quoted in Financial Bid.

40. The Contractor shall ensure compliance of all statutory Laws and bye laws of the Central Govt./ State Govt./ Municipal authorities related to the employment of their staff and all such obligation under wage act., workmen compensation act., ESI act., provident fund and Miscellaneous provision Act. Bonus Act. And contract labour Act. 1970 and amendments time to time etc. IUAC will not be responsible for such lapses in any way.

41. Payment of bills:

- a) Bill will be submitted by the Contractor on quarterly basis and after satisfactory service and submission of pre-receipted bill along with documents in support of payment of wages to worker through RTGS / NEFT only. Proof of remittance of Salary to Employees / PF/ ESI/ GST / any other documents as prescribed by the Institute to respective agencies are also required to be submitted with bill.
- b) Wages: Wages shall have the same meaning as defined in payment of Wages Act. The contractor shall pay his workers not below the rates under Minimum wages act declared by Govt. Of NCT and to comply with various Labour Acts such as PF, ESI, Bonus, and Maternity, Contract (R7A) SAVY 1970, contract Labour (R&A) Central Rules 1971 and any other acts applicable as amended from time to time at his own expenses.
- c) TDS on payments will be made as per rules in this regard.
- d) The payments to all workers deployed should be made in full by 1st of every calendar month.
- e) GST shall be paid @ 5 % as per GOI notification Nos. 45/2017 & 47/2017 dated 14/11/2017. The exemption certificate shall be provided at the time of issue of Work Order [**Only for supply of spare parts**].

42. The department reserves the right to terminate the contract by giving one month notice in writing during the period of the contract without any financial repercussions on either side.

43. If the services provided by the agency under this maintenance services contract are not to the full satisfaction of IUAC, the maintenance contract may be terminated by IUAC and the charges shall be payable only up to the period, till the agency has rendered satisfaction services. The decision of IUAC in this regards shall be final and binding on the agency.

44. The resident technician provided by agency shall not be changed frequently. Any change shall be with the consent of Institute.

45. All the persons deployed by the contractor at IUAC site will have to carry valid gate pass, which will be issued after submission of their bio-data in desired format by the contractor. Any negligence/offense on their part will attract immediate removal of person(s) from site.

46. All the employees of the contractor working at our site will have to be covered under insurance against any personal accident and IUAC will not be liable for payment of any compensation on that account.

47. The periodic maintenance, installation, repair works shall be carried out as per the norms set by the manufacturer of respective equipment specification and specific instructions as may be issued by the IUAC Engineer responsible for work from time to time.

48. During execution of work the bidder should follow all standard norms of safety measures/ precautions to avoid accident/ damages to persons, machines and buildings. On non- adherence of this clause, suitable fines as decided by the Director IUAC shall be imposed.

49. No material belonging to the bidder whether consumable or non-consumable should be brought inside the IUAC campus without proper entry at the main gate nor any material should be taken out without proper gate pass issued by the Centre.
50. Tenders once submitted will remain with the Centre and will never be returned to the bidders.
51. Corrections in the Tender: All figures shall be clearly and legibly written in the tender and with the same pen and ink. Erasing and overwriting is not allowed.
52. Tender submission by a firm: In the event of tender being submitted by a firm or company (i.e. not by an individual), it must be signed by an authorized signatory.
53. All Rates to be filled: Bidder shall fill rates of all the items and no item should be left blank. Failure to fill rates of some items may lead to rejection of tender and it will be assumed that contractor is not interested to do these works.
54. Termination of Contract: The Director, IUAC reserve the right to terminate the contract on account of poor workmanship, failure to start the work within stipulated time, non-compliance of set norms / specifications for the works, delay in progress of work, violation of any contract provisions by the bidder. The contract can also be terminated at the request of the bidder within 10 days from the date of LOI / purchase order. In such case the EMD of the bidder will be forfeited. If the contractor requests the termination of contract any time after submission of performance bank guarantee, the Performance Bank Guarantee shall be encashed along with forfeiture of EMD.
55. In force-majeure condition / unforeseen circumstances, like pandemic, etc., the centre deserves the rights to suspend the contract for a temporary period, for which the bidder has no right to claim any compensation towards AMC / service charges etc., during the suspension period.
56. The successful bidder shall not assign, transfer, pledge or subcontract the services included in the awarded tender, without the prior written consent of the centre.

LEGAL

1. The successful agency/bidder shall maintain all statutory registers under the law. The agency shall produce the same, on demand to the concerned authority of IUAC or any other authorities under law.
2. The tax deduction at source (TDS) shall be made as per the provisions of Income Tax Act and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the agency by the IUAC.
3. Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of it or relating to means, operation of the contract or the breach thereof shall be settled by mutual consultations, failing which, shall be referred to sole Arbitration or an Arbitrator to be appointed by Director, IUAC. The award of the arbitration shall be final and binding on the parties as per terms and conditions of the agreement executed on the award of the contract. The Arbitrator proceeding shall be conducted in Delhi.
4. All legal disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.
5. The IUAC shall not be responsible for any financial loss or any injury to any person deployed by service providing agency/bidder in the course of their performing the functions/duties or for payment towards any compensation.

Part-II: Scope of Work with Special Terms & Conditions

1. Details of audio & video systems of auditorium of IUAC campus

At IUAC various academic courses, symposiums, workshops, internal and external meeting, conferences, seminars, cultural events are conducted throughout the year utilising the following facilities. The main auditorium complex, various rooms, halls in the campus are installed with various kinds of audio and video equipment along with associated electrical, electronic and mechanical systems.

1. The auditorium complex in IUAC campus comprises a 300+ seater main auditorium, a 50+ seater seminar hall, a 21 seater conference room, green rooms [2 nos.] and two levels of lobby area.
2. The main laboratory building have a 40 seat Ph.D classroom, a 90+ seater seminar hall, a council room and a committee room.

Note: Hereafter, Audio & video systems refers to audio & video equipment along with associated electrical, electronic (computer included) and mechanical systems in this document.

The audio & video systems were installed and commissioned in the year 2017-18 and thereafter. The conference room of main auditorium complex, seminar hall, meeting rooms of the main laboratory building are installed with basic data projectors and audio equipment. The equipment installed in these places are listed in the Annexure: VI along with their date of installation and warranty period where applicable.

2. Scope of Works: The “Annual maintenance and operation of Audio & Video Systems within IUAC Campus, New Delhi” is service in nature.

It is proposed to appoint a vendor with appropriate skills and experience for the management of installed Audio and Video systems at IUAC and associated services. The vendor would manage the same by assigning to IUAC, one resident technician preferably a ITI certificate holder or a Diploma holder (State or Central Board certificate in Electrical or Electronics or Radio & TV engineering trade) with at least 2 years of experience in handling various audio, video, stage lighting and computer equipment for operation on a 5 days a week (including weekends, holidays), 8 hours a day basis, who would work under the supervision of IUAC personnel and have access to the vendor's remote resources.

2.1 The following works are to be done by the successful bidder during Contract period

2.1.1. Trained resident technician will be available at IUAC during all working days / weekend / holidays depending upon arising requirements, in consultation with successful bidder and IUAC personnel.

2.1.2. The responsibilities of supplied manpower shall be to periodically power and check all the equipment of audio & video systems for the performances as per installed specifications (check list will be provided for each facility), prepare the same for immediate use, operate the equipment during programme whenever such requirement arises, and same shall be documented and counter verified by person in charge. Any computer software updation if required for these equipment, shall be carried out periodically in consultation with person in charge of IUAC.

2.1.3 The responsibilities of supplied manpower shall be to periodically service all the installed equipment including hardware and software for preventive maintenance as well as incidental repair at site, except the major equipments listed in Annexure-VII.

2.1.4. Any major equipment (listed in Annexure-VII) repair and re-installation of stalled equipment shall be carried out by the contractor in consultation with person in charge, and if needed the faulty equipment be taken out for repair to the manufacturer's nearby authorised repair/service centre by the contractor. Liasoning responsibility with service centre lies with contractor for successful repair and retrieving the serviced equipment back into the system within a reasonable time. Any cost involving the consumable not covered under warranty clause of the equipment, will be reimbursed based on the original bill supplied and certified by the person in charge. Standard purchase rules of IUAC for payment will be applicable in all such cases.

2.1.5 Any mishandling or accidental damage to the equipment by the contractor personnel need to be borne by the contractor without any additional cost to IUAC. The contractor is bound to oblige the decision of the concerned IUAC authority in this regard.

3. Period of execution

- Attending to all requirements given by the department within 24 hours. Minor complaints or alterations shall be carried out within 3 working days.
- Whenever major repair of equipment involves third party / OEM authorised service centre, the same shall be carried out within 15 days after obtaining due approval from IUAC personnel.
- The delay in attending complaint within above stipulated time will invite a penalty ranging from Rs.1000/- to Rs.5000/- at the discretion of the department on each complaint.

4. List of items

The Annexure: VI is a list of installed electrical, mechanical, audio & video, stage lighting, computer and software is attached.

Special Terms and Conditions of the Tender:

1. The IUAC shall have right to adjust and/or deduct any of the amounts as aforesaid from the payments against any loss of IUAC assets and property due to mishandling by the person authorised by the contractor under this contract.
2. The successful agency/bidder shall furnish the following documents in respect of resident technician who will be deployed by it in the IUAC before the commencement of work: Bio-data of person along with the certificate in respect of educational/professional qualification etc.
3. The successful agency/bidders shall be responsible for proper conduct of his/her personnel in IUAC office premises.
4. The personnel deputed to IUAC by the successful agency/bidders should be polite, cordial, positive and efficient while handling the assigned work.
